Application Process:

- Step 2:** Complete this application form and select all awards for which you wish to be considered. Only one application form is required.
- Step 3:** Attach supporting documentation (letter from your counselor, medical certificate and/or a learning-disability assessment completed by a qualified practitioner) if you are applying for awards that have specific criteria.
- Step 4:** Submit package (hard copy of Student Financial Profile, hard copy of application for Awards for Students with Disabilities and supporting documentation, if applicable) via drop box or by mail to locations indicated below.
